Form B Process: It was learned by the Chair that Massachusetts Historical Commission (MHC) will accept updated Form B's only if they have current photos and a locus map.



The Chair reported that the Town Administrator wanted to limit the HC participation to MCLA and BCC at this time.

On a motion duly made and seconded (Tucker/Elsbach), it was voted to apply to MCLA and BCC to participate in the Federal Work-Study Program. (7-0-0). The Chair will follow through on this as the completed applications are due 07.01.2014.

Gay Tucker volunteered to talk with Jim Miller and Paul O'Brien of the Historical Society and develop some guidelines for the work that could be done by students from each institution. In addition she will provide some oversight of the work. Other Commission members volunteered to provide oversight as well.
