

MINUTES
Public Hearing for James Cavanaugh
Special Permit Application for a Sign larger than permitted by right
Case # 042309

Thursday, June 11, 2009

The public hearing was opened at 8:05 PM.

Planning Board members present were: Christopher Tomich, David Smith Sr., Peter Cherneff and Timothy Fulco. Anthony Gulotta was present as an alternate member. Margaret Martin was absent.

Neither the applicant nor any members of the public were present.

C. Tomich read the legal notice of the Public Hearing into the public record.

C. Tomich explained the purpose of the Special Permit Hearing and conducted the hearing. He stated that James Cavanaugh would like permission to put up a sign for his business that is 12 feet square. Notices were sent to neighboring towns and all applicable commissions. A check for \$250 was enclosed with the application for the Special Permit.

P. Cherneff asked about lighting for the sign. Planning Board members thought that since the business closes at 5 p.m., lighting would probably be unnecessary. C. Tomich volunteered to ask the applicant about lighting.

A. Gulotta suggested that the Board delineate lighting requirements in the conditions for the Special Permit.

At 8:20 PM, D. Smith Sr. made a motion, seconded and approved 5-0, to close the public hearing.
