Chairman Smith opened the meeting at 6:35 PM.

Discussion ensued regarding funding for the District Local Technical Assistance program. Selectman Hannum moved to send Senator Benjamin Downing a letter requesting his support for funding the statewide DLTA, seconded by Selectman Wood. The motion carried unanimously.

The Sheffield Fire Department has submitted an application for a Temporary Roadside Event Sign Permit for the Mother's Day Pancake Breakfast to be held on May 12, 2013 at the Sheffield Fire Department. The sign was erected on the Village Green on May 1, 2013, and will be removed on May 12, 2013. Selectman Wood moved to approve a Temporary Roadside Event Signs for the Mother's Day Pancake Breakfast to be held at the Sheffield Fire Department on May 12, 2013 as presented with relocation of the sign to allow view of oncoming traffic when exiting the Village Green, seconded by Selectman Hannum. The motion carried unanimously.

Rene Wood, with the Town of Sheffield Board of Health has submitted an application for a Temporary Roadside Event Sign Permit for the Tick Tock event to be held on May 11, 2013 at Dewey Hall. The sign will be erected on the Village Green on May 8, 2013 and will be removed no later than May 13, 2013. Selectman Hannum moved to approve the Temporary Roadside Event Sign for the Tick Tock event to be held at Dewey Hall on May 11, 2013 as presented, seconded by Selectman Wood. The motion carried unanimously.

Selectman Hannum stated that Joshua Ostroff has contacted her asking that the Board of Selectman write a letter to the editor regarding the Transportation Bill, discussion ensued. It was the consensus of the Board to not write a letter to the editor. Selectman Hannum moved to authorize Selectman Wood to speak to our legislators regarding the Transportation Bill, seconded by Selectman Wood. The motion carried unanimously.

Selectman Hannum moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Selectman Wood. The motion carried unanimously.
