

ADDITIONAL SHEFFIELD TRANSFER STATION RECYCLE / REUSE PROGRAMS

If any questions, please ask the Attendant for assistance

- **Mercury bearing products:** Use the Lighting Shed for depositing fluorescent lamps/CFLs, button batteries, thermostats, thermometers, other products containing mercury
- **Books & Media:** including soft and hard bound books, VHS, BETA and VIDEO tapes. Please no CD's. (There is an additional book bin at the Senior Center but takes books only for recycling/reuse.)
- **Household batteries:** Use the Electronics Bin for most alkaline and all non-alkaline batteries, such as Rechargeable, Lithium, ION, Nickel Cadmium (NiCad), Alkaline; Lead acid, and button. Please use the containers provided unless you have a standalone battery.
- **Swap Shop:** Almost everyone's favorite spot at the Transfer Station. Please drop off reusable home goods, books, toys, puzzles, clothing you wish to give someone the opportunity to select before it goes in the Textile Bin and other usable items. General Rule: if you wouldn't want it or its not clean – please do not leave it in the Swap Shop.
- **Eyeglasses:** A box on the wall of the Swap Shop collects glasses for the Lions Club. Prescription glasses only. Please, no glass cases or sunglasses.
- **Artist Cabinet:** Bushnell-Sage Library's bright red artist cabinet is filled with free art supplies from paper to paints, brushes, decorations, and all sorts of usable and useful items for art projects of all kinds – whether they be personal projects, school, or group projects. Available on the lower level. Please consider taking your art supplies there and check in with the front desk before putting anything in the cabinet.
