


To the Constables of the Town of Sheffield in said County, Greeting:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Sheffield qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet in the auditorium of the Mount Everett Regional High School, 489 Berkshire School Road in Sheffield on Monday, March 18, 2024, at 6:00 P.M. then and there to act upon the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Select Board to acquire, by purchase, gift, or eminent domain and upon such terms and conditions as the Selectmen deem appropriate, for general municipal purposes, the fee or lesser interest in all or a portion of the land and improvements thereon located at 48 Sheffield Business Park, identified as Assessor's Parcel ID 2670080000400201 and more particularly described in a deed recorded with Berkshire South Registry of Deeds at Book 1636, Page 46; and, further, to see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, borrow, or transfer from available funds, or any combination thereof, a sum of money for the acquisition of said property, and all costs incidental and related thereto; and, further, to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into all agreements, execute any and all instruments, and take all related actions necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes of this vote; or take any other action relative thereto.
