- The Ag Com will post a memo in the January/February issue of the Sheffield Times calling for responses from all farmers. The deadline for submission of the memo is December 15. Erna will post the memo.
- The Ag Com will consult the Sheffield Farmers' Market Steering Committee for suggestions regarding survey questions.
- Erna will send Jim Kelly an invoice for \$400.
- Two ideas were suggested for the brochure: add to our farmer list by looking at the Chapter 61-A list, and include an opportunity in the survey for farms to send in photos.

Treasurer's report:

Biosolids:

The Ag Com has yet to share information regarding state and federal regulations that pertain to biosolids use as fertilizer with the Larkin Farm. Update pending.
