Chairman Pitman called the meeting to Order at 7:00 p.m.

Chairman Pitman made adjustments to the order of the agenda.

Consultants for property on Bow Wow Road / Mill Pond, in accordance with the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 131, sec. 40. The proposed project is being filed in order to renew a permit for the continued maintenance of Mill Pond, this maintenance includes invasive and nuisance aquatic vegetation management to improve the ecological health of the pond. Chairman Pitman welcomed back Sarah Williams from the Mill Pond Association. Sarah respectfully asked for another continuance due to delays of the projects review from Natural Heritage. M. Mitsoff motioned, with a second from A. Batacchi, Jr. to continue the public hearing for the Notice of Intent submitted by SWCA Environmental Consultants for the property on Bow Wow Road / Mill Pond to the March 9, 2020 meeting.

Public Hearing: Request for Determination of Applicability, filed by Berkshire Soil & Water for property located at 290 Bow Wow Road, Sheffield, in accordance with the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 131, sec. 40. The purpose of the hearing is to gather information regarding the proposed project: M. Mitsoff gave a description of the site. M. Mitsoff motioned, with a second from T. Pitman, issuing a #3 negative determination with the condition that the septic installer follow through with the described erosion controls on the site sketch in the request.

Request for Certificate of Compliance for 290 Bow Wow Road: M. Mitsoff gave a description of the site. A discussion ensued regarding the work that had been done in the past and it how the quality work has sustained itself for many years. M. Mitsoff motioned, with a second from T. Pitman, to approve the certificate of compliance for 290 Bow Wow Road.

Conservation Commission Minutes February 10, 2020 Meeting Page 1 of 3 Continued Public Hearing: Request for Determination of Applicability, filed by White Engineering Inc. for property on Rannapo Rd, Sheffield, in accordance with the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 131, sec. 40. The purpose of the hearing is to gather information regarding the proposed project: Construction of a garage on north side of house. Garage will be constructed 60 ft. from the Bordering Vegetated Wetland. Garage will be 26' x 22' in size. During construction, erosion control silt fence will be installed 15ft of the excavation limits, between the excavation and the wetland. At the completion of work all disturbed soils will be seeded and mulched. Driveway surface will be gravel. Silt fence will serve as the limit of work area and tree removal. M. Mitsoff gave a description of the site and stated that the project is even farther from the wetlands than the applicant's original request. M. Mitsoff motioned, with a second from T. Pitman to issue a #2 negative determination for the nine acre parcel on Rannapo Road known as the Annunziata property, with the condition that they follow through with the described erosion controls listed on the site sketch in their request.

Request for Certificate of Compliance for 394 Berkshire School Road. A discussion ensued regarding the information provided by the applicant and the site visit made today. <u>D. Ward motioned</u>, with a second M. Mitsoff to continue this matter to the March 9, 2020 meeting, pending the availability of the missing documentation.

Enforcement Order: 1448 South Undermountain Road. The Commission reviewed the email correspondence from Emily Stockman. The Commissions understanding is that the plans have been submitted. A discussion ensued regarding what will happen next. The Commission decided that they will ask Emily Stockman to follow up with the engineer Mike Kulig and Natural Heritage for updates on their progress.

Approval of Minutes: January 13, 2020: The Commission reviewed the draft meeting minutes from January 13, 2020. <u>A. Batacchi Jr. motioned with a second from M. Mitsoff to accept the January 13, 2020 minutes as presented. The motion passed 4-0.</u>
