COVID-19 Vaccination Update, February 17, 2021

Effective tomorrow, February 18, <u>individuals aged 65 and older</u> AND <u>individuals with two or more specified</u> <u>medical conditions (listed below)</u> AND <u>residents and staff of public and private low-income and affordable se-</u><u>nior housing</u> will be eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine under Phase 2, Group 2.

Individuals must pre-register to receive vaccinations - whether at a mass vaccination site or a regional site or at certain pharmacies and health offices that are also providing vaccinations for these groups as well as the groups that preceded them in Phase 1 and Phase 2, Group 1. Details on registration resources are provided below.

For the time being, COVID-19 vaccinations require two (2) "jabs" (or shots) to build immunity to the virus, so eligible individuals that register for a vaccination will be scheduling their first jab and will be provided with information on how and when they are to receive their second jab.

Specified Medical Conditions

Individuals aged 16 and older with two (2) or more of the following medical conditions can get vaccinated in Phase 2, Group 2:

- Cancer
- Chronic kidney disease
- COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease)
- Down syndrome
- Heart conditions such as heart failure, coronary artery disease, or cardiomyopathies
- Immunocompromised individuals (i.e., weakened immune system) the result of a solid organ transplant
- Asthma (moderate to severe)
- Obesity and severe obesity based on Adult Body Mass Index
- Pregnancy
- Sickle cell disease
- Smoking
- Type 2 diabetes mellitus

Individuals that have questions regarding whether they suffer from two or more of these medical conditions, or who are hesitant to get the vaccine, should **consult their primary care provider** first before registering to receive a vaccination.
