**COVID-19 Vaccinations Update, February 5, 2021**

The Berkshire Vaccine Collaborative is coordinating COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics in Pittsfield, Great Barrington and North Adams. Massachusetts is currently in Phase 2-A of the vaccination program, which means that Berkshire County residents ages 75 and older are eligible to receive the vaccine. Please understand that the number of available appointments is limited by the amount of vaccines currently being distributed by the state and federal governments and it will likely take several weeks to complete this first part of Phase 2.
