Chairman Collingwood called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Continuation of Public Hearing: Special Permit Application of Edward Ustico for property located on Polikoff Road, for a construction business and related heavy vehicle storage, per Section 3.1.3 (E-2) of the Sheffield Zoning By-Laws.

G. Oleen motioned, with a second from K. Smith to open the public hearing. The motion passed 5-0.

Chairman Collingwood announced that the meeting was being recorded. Mr. Ustico reviewed and discussed with the Board the revised site plan, photos to illustrate the concept of a future proposed building and a letter from his engineer. Jared Clayton asked why there were no wetlands marked on the site plan. Chairman Collingwood stated that bordering vegetated wetlands, buffer zones and the flood plain are marked on the site plan and that Mr. Ustico would have to go before the Conservation Commission if his Special Permit was granted. Several residents were present and spoke in favor of the application. Jared Clayton requested that the Board continue the public hearing so he and his neighbors could review the new information that was submitted. A discussion ensued.

Abutters of the property expressed concerns about their property values decreasing and equipment and materials that are stored on the property. Mr. Ustico explained to the Board that he has only one dump truck and a variety of trailers and that his primary business is in Connecticut. A building would allow him to put his equipment under cover. M. Massini-Reynolds explained that in the Zoning By-Laws storage or placement of vehicles visible from a public highway or adjacent properties shall not be allowed. A discussion ensued about screening on the property. G. Oleen motioned with a second from D. Martin to close the public hearing. The motion passed 5-0. The public hearing closed at 7:42 p.m.

The Board began their deliberations. A discussion ensued about special conditions. G. Oleen motioned, with a second from D. Martin to grant the Special Permit for Edward Ustico with the following conditions:

1. Applicant will clean up the junk (oil tanks and unregistered vehicles) on the property.

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 Applicant will be considerate of neighbors' site lines.
 Applicant will maintain the existing natural screening on the property and/or install additional screening to be in compliance.

The motion passed 5-0.

G. Oleen motioned, with a second from D. Martin to close deliberations. The motion passed 5-0.

Continuation of Public Hearing: Special Permit Application of Park Avenue Solar Solutions for property located on Clayton Road, for a Large Scale Solar Photovoltaic Installation, per Section 7.4 of the Sheffield Zoning By-Laws.

G. Oleen motioned, with a second from D. Martin to open the public hearing. The motion passed 5-0.

M. Massini-Reynolds recused herself from the hearing because she is a family friend and is related to a business associate.

Alana Chain and Kirt Mayland were present for the applicant. Ms. Chain handed out a packet of information to the Board. The tree planting plan was reviewed and discussed. The screening will be extended along the property line by the Emerling property and screening will also added to the North side of the property that will extend diagonally to the West over to the access road. There will be about 103-105 plantings total. She talked about the Arborist review of tree greeimen and planting plan. Tomich Landscape Design about the Arborist review of tree specimen and planting plan. Tomich Landscape Design has chosen the Green Giant Arborvitae for screening. It is deer resistant, adaptable to amended gravel soil, dry tolerant and will grow to a maximum of 35-40'. They are proposing to plant 7-8' trees. Abutter Paul Emerling showed photos of his property to the Board. He feels the trees should be taller and planted in a straight line along the section by his property rather than a diagonal line. A lengthy discussion ensued about trees and the placement of them. Kirt Mayland stated that they could plant 12-14' trees staggered along the side of the Emerling property and 7-8' trees in other areas.

Ms. Chain discussed the heat and glare concerns with the solar panels. She presented the Solar and Glare article from Meister Consultants Group. The solar panels are designed to absorb sunlight and only reflect about 2 percent of light. Mr. Mayland stated they have never had any glare issues. Mr. Emerling presented several on-line news articles to the Board. A discussion ensued about solar glare. Mr. Mayland agreed to do a glare study and present it at the April 11th meeting.

Heat issues with solar panels were discussed. Ms. Chain spoke about module temperature sensors and reviewed the data from the East Stahl Road solar field. The data is from April, August, October and December of 2017. She also referred to the Questions and Answers on Ground-Mounted Solar Photovoltaic Systems, which was included in the packet. She stated that the site will have no increase in temperature from heat off the solar panels.

Mr. Emerling has concerns about the wind making noise when they hit the solar panels. Mr. Mayland discussed the noise analysis for the proposed project dated March 20, 2018. A discussion ensued.

Mr. Emerling also stated his concerns about wildlife in the area. Mr. Mayland said that a review was done by the Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program and they have determined that the project would not result in a take. He said that they will be installing turtle gates on the site.

The Board asked the applicant to come to the next meeting with the information that was requested.

G. Oleen motioned, with a second from D. Martin to continue the public hearing to April 11, 2018. The motion passed 4-0.

G. Oleen motioned, with a second from M. Massini-Reynolds to open the public meeting. The motion passed 5-0. The public meeting opened at 9:24 p.m.

Form A Requests: There were no Form A requests.

Discussion with Berkshire Regional Planning Commission regarding the Hazard Mitigation Plan: There was no discussion as Lauren Gaherty was not present.

Approval of Minutes: The Board reviewed draft meeting minutes of March 14, 2018. G. Oleen motioned, with a second from K. Smith to approve the March 14, 2018 minutes as written. The motion passed 4-0. M. Massini-Reynolds abstained from the vote.
