- Brown paper bags stamped or colored
- Comics & magazines; old maps & posters
- Children's artwork
- Leftover wallpaper; brown paper bags
- Fabric & tablecloths; Boxes & baskets
- Homemade wrapping paper
- Cups & mugs

#### Holiday cards made from

- Used cards, postcards, or nature photos
- Calendar pictures
- Homemade cards using recycled paper

## Alternative gift ideas

- Donate in the name of a family member/ friend to a cause they support
- Re-gift an unused item or gift certificate
- Check out thrift stores, used bookstores, & used music stores for finds. Don't forget the Swap Shop.
- Give tickets or gift certificates to anything, including takeout meals
- **Give someone a membership** to an organization they support
- Create a scrapbook
- Make something homemade cookies, fudge, a dinner, homemade scarf, mittens, special dog/cat treats
- **Give time** zoom / phone call / visit
- Give an errand or service, like food shopping, doing nails, or taking the dog for walks

## What Can I Recycle?

### YES, please recycle:

- Paper shopping bags rope & plastic handles are acceptable
- **Gift tissue paper** no metallics or glitter
- Gift wrap/gift bags no metallics or glitter
- Greeting cards no foil or wire
- Paperboard gift boxes
- Corrugated cardboard boxes
- Catalogs
- **String lights** must be in a box with lid; Electronics container. NEW!

## But NO, can't recycle:

- Ribbons, bows, tinsel
- Anything with Metallics / glitter
- Packing peanuts or Styrofoam blocks
- Plastic blister packaging from toys or electronics; cards with batteries

#### The New Mantra:

**RETHINK** - Choices

**REFUSE** - Single Use

**REDUCE** - Consumption

**REUSE** – Everything

**REFILL** – Containers

**REFURBISH** - Old Stuff

**REPAIR** - Before Replacing

**REPURPOSE** - Be Creative!

**RECYCLE** - Last Option
