Southern Berkshire Public Health Collaborative to offer Pop-up Drive Through Rapid COVID-19 testing Clinics in Lee and Sheffield

LEE/SHEFFIELD— To help residents make safe decisions about gathering for the holidays and returning to work or school after possible exposures, the Southern Berkshire Public Health Collaborative will offer pop-up, drive-thru rapid COVID testing clinics in Lee and Sheffield. The dates/times are:

January 4, 2022, in Lee 2:00-4:00pm at the Airoidi Building, 45 Railroad Street

January 6, 2022, in Sheffield 8:00-10:00am at the Bushnell-Sage Library, 48 Main Street

Advance registration is required. Testing is free. Both children and adults are eligible, whether symptomatic or not. Antigen test results will be shared the same day.
