To the Constables of the Town of Sheffield in said County, *Greeting.*

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Sheffield qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet in the auditorium of the Mount Everett Regional High School on Berkshire School Road in Sheffield on Wednesday, August 10, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. then and there to act upon the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,812,155 to pay a portion of the Town's assessed share of the Southern Berkshire Regional School District Operating and Transportation Budget for Fiscal Year 2012.

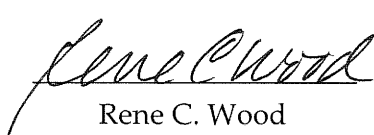
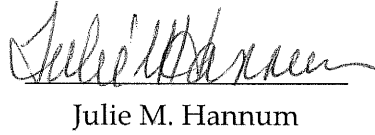
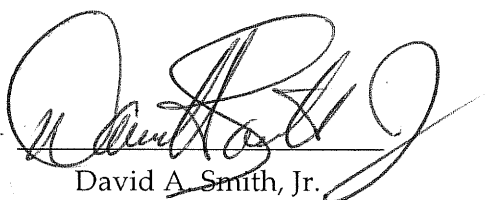
ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate an additional \$29,943 to pay a portion of the Town's assessed share of the Southern Berkshire Regional School District Operating and Transportation Budget for Fiscal Year 2012, said appropriation to be contingent on the passage of a Proposition 2½ override in the amount of \$28,000.

You are directed to serve this Warrant by posting an attested copy in seven public places in the Town, not less than fourteen days before the date of said meeting.
